



Dear Applicant,

The Hampden County 4-H / Youth Special Fund awards scholarships to qualified post high school or college level Hampden County 4-H members, former members or Hampden County applicants involved in a previous or current agricultural endeavor. To apply for a scholarship, fill out the application form completely and comply with the requirements on **page 2**. Return the application materials to the address listed at the bottom of **page 1**.

The scholarship criteria are as follows:

- 1. The applicant must show current or previous involvement in an agricultural endeavor, is a farm family member or a 4-H club member (verification necessary). Preference will be given to students majoring in agricultural studies.
- 2. The applicant must be a resident of Hampden County for a minimum of two years.
- 3. The applicant must complete all admission requirements for a degree granting college or university.
- 4. The applicant must show evidence of academic potential and have a grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.2.
- 5. The applicant must fully complete all the application materials required to be a scholarship candidate.
- Applications and pertinent information must be post marked or received by June 1<sup>st</sup>. Any information received after that date will not be considered. No exceptions.
- 7. Recipients of the scholarship will be notified by July 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 8. No awards shall be issued if, at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee, there are no qualified applicants.
- Scholarships shall be payable directly to the college during the second semester. Transcripts from the first semester, indicating at least 12 credits hours or equivalent and a GPA of at least 2.2, must be received by January 16<sup>th</sup> before payment is made.
- 10. Scholarships may be renewed by completing the *Re-Application Scholarship Form*. A cumulative GPA of at least 2.2 and a minimum of 24 credit hours or equivalent must be achieved each year.
- 11. Scholarships are limited to four years unless the applicant is pursuing post-graduate studies in an agricultural field. Renewal applications will be sent to previous recipients.
- 12. Each scholarship will be in an amount up to \$1,000.00.

- 3 copies of the activities/award/experience list
- 2 letters of recommendation
- Most recent grade transcript
